I certify that all conditions of the Contestable Works Agreement and Negotiated Connection Contract have been met before submitting this 'Tie in Request'. I acknowledge that should the constructed works not meet the required Powercor standards, this Tie-In Request and the associated Certificate of Practical Completion will be cancelled. If cancellation occurs, I acknowledge that submission of a new Certificate of Practical Completion and Tie In Request will be required.

Where the consideration for Powercor to provide early consent to the issue of statement of compliance is requested

I understand that Powercor Australia Ltd is under no obligation to provide early consent to the issue of Statement of Compliance. Early consent will only be considered where the customer has a proven history of delivering quality assets to Powercor for audit and connection to the electrical distribution network. I have engaged an appropriate 'A' rated customer appointed project manager, and 'A' or 'B' rated V.E.N.D. Auditor to complete all work on this project. I agree to the following terms:

By submitting this application, the customer confirms that all Planning Permit conditions placed on the development by Powercor Australia Ltd have been satisfied, and no third-party constraints or the staging order of the development will prevent the works from being connected to the electricity distribution network.

The customer agrees:

- Not to re-assign any rebates payable for this development to any other party, and payment for any rebates will not be processed until after tie in.
 - To a variation in the Contestable Works Agreement, Clause 13.1 to extend the period the customer is solely responsible for all risks and liabilities associated with the works until Powercor ties the works into its electricity distribution network and to exclude sub-clause "(b) 20 business Days after the date the Certificate of Practical Completion has been countersigned by Powercor."
 - To submit the certificate of practical completion, along with a compliant Powercor audit within 30 business days of submitting this request.
 - If any of the following occurs that impacts Powercor's tie in works and delay's connection of supply to the development:
 - (a) The Certificate of Practical completion is not submitted to Powercor's Responsible officer by the agreed date; or
 - (b) The complying Powercor Final Audit is not submitted to Powercor's Responsible officer by the agreed date; or
 - (c) Powercor discovers the Works are defective or damaged at the time Powercor proposes to tie the Works into its electricity distribution network.
- The customer will:
1. Notify all lot owners and potential lot owners that there may be a delay in supply being made available to the development beyond Powercor's control; and
 2. Manage all Customer enquiries regarding the availability of supply from lot owners in the development.; and
 3. Agree to be liable for any claims arising from a delay in supply being available to the development.
- If Powercor Australia Ltd suffers reputational or financial damage as a result of any omissions or actions by the customer and Powercor providing early consent; Powercor Australia Ltd may, at its sole discretion, not allow the customer to make an application for early issue of consent for statement of compliance in the future.
 - To pay a contract variation fee of \$526 GST Exclusive.

Where the customer has requested a '4 week' tie in.

The customer agrees to submit the certificate of practical completion, along with a compliant Powercor audit, within 30 business days of submitting this request. If the customer fails to submit the certificate of practical completion by this date, the tie in will be rejected in mySupply, and a new tie in request will need to be submitted; the project will no longer be eligible for a '4-week' tie in, and a standard '10-week' tie in will be applicable.
